How to Play

Introduction

Lucky 8™ Reactors is an exciting video-slot reactor game that will take you on a journey to explore the five elemental worlds where fortune dragons and destiny await you. Connect five or more symbols, either horizontally and/or vertically, to win a cash payout. Help our lady warrior summon one of the elemental dragons and unleash one of their special features to win awesome prizes. Will you be able to reach the Golden World and summon the Golden Dragon for the chance to land a huge win?

Lucky 8™ Reactors features:

- Five elemental worlds
- A Golden Cashpot
- 5 dragons, each with a unique special feature
- A random Golden Dragon Blessing feature that may appear if you don't have a current win
- Golden Wild symbol that multiplies your winning cluster by x8

How to Win

When the initial symbol drop is complete, and the grid is full of symbols, several things may happen.

If you have five or more symbols connected, horizontally and/or vertically, they will explode, and you will win a payout. A winning combination of five or more matching symbols is called a cluster. Diagonally linked symbols do not create a connection for winning clusters. It is possible to get multiple clusters wins in the same game with each cluster adding to the overall win total. Payouts increase depending on the number of matching symbols you have and the value of the symbol itself. Check out the payable to see which symbols pay what amounts.

Each time you have a cluster win those symbols will explode and new symbols will drop in from the top of the grid to fill the vacant spaces, potentially creating more winning clusters.

For example:

If new cluster wins occur from the newly descended symbols, the above sequence is repeated until there are no more winning clusters, and that specific game will complete.

Any winnings are displayed and added automatically to your balance.

Paytable

Payout values increase depending upon the type and number of symbols being matched in a cluster. Payout values of winning cluster are multiplied by your game stake to calculate the cash prize for each winning cluster. See in-game for the paytable.

Five Worlds and the Golden Cashpot

There are five Worlds in the game which appear in this order: Water, Wood, Fire, Earth and Gold.

To progress from each World to the next one you to clear the two grid patterns that are associated with each of them. To clear the patterns, you need to get a winning cluster where the symbol explodes on each spot indicated in the pattern. When you have had a winning symbol explosion on each spot of the 2 patterns for each World, you will continue your journey by moving to the next World.

When you clear the Earth World you will automatically move to the Gold World and win the Golden Cashpot.

Golden Cashpot

The Golden Cashpot is a cumulative cashpot, specific only to your gameplay, that increments with a portion of every winning payout you achieve. An amount equivalent to 10% of all wins, starting from the first game played in the Water World until you win the cashpot, are added to the Golden Cashpot. Once the Golden Cashpot has been awarded, it will reset to zero.

Wild Symbols

Wild symbols cannot drop from regular falls and can appear only under a specific condition.

The world background interacts with its associated symbols that have the same element. When there is a winning cluster of a group of symbols that match the world background, that winning cluster will explode and leave 2 regular wild symbols behind.

For example, if you have a winning cluster of Water symbol and you are in the water world, the symbols will explode and produce 2 wild symbols.

Wild symbols can replace any symbol except the Golden Wild symbol.

The Golden Wild symbol can only appear during the Golden Dragon feature. All winning combinations produced with one or more Golden Wild(s) are paid with an x8 win multiplier.

Reactor Meter & Dragon Feature

The Reactor meter can contain up to 5 dragon summon bars. There is a counter that tracks the number of symbols that have exploded and indicates the numbers of symbol explosions required to get the next dragon summon bar. A wild symbol that is part of a winning cluster and explodes will also count towards the meter.

If there are enough symbol explosions to fill a Reactor meter bar, a dragon summon stone will fall in the Reactor meter. When there are no more winning clusters, and you have an unused dragon summon stone in the reactor meter, our lady warrior will summon one of the dragons to unleash its special feature and give a chance to create more winning cluster.

If there are new winning clusters that have been formed after a dragon has unleashed its special feature, the game will carry on with the winning symbols exploding and new symbols falling into the grid. Once there are no more winning cluster, the game ends unless there is an unused dragon summon stone in which case the lady warrior will summon another dragon.

The first 4 dragon summon bars will randomly summon one dragon from the Water, Wood, Fire or Earth dragon. The fifth dragon summon bar will always summon the Golden Dragon.

Water Dragon Feature

When the Water Dragon comes into play, it will fly towards one of the squares in the corner of the grid and mark the symbol in that square as the starting symbol. The Water Dragon will then continue its flight in a diagonal flying path to the opposite square on the grid. Random symbols that were on the flying path of the Water Dragon will then turn into the starting symbol. It is possible that the starting symbol is a wild symbol.

Fire Dragon Feature

When the Fire Dragon comes into play, it will burn and eliminate the low paying symbols Water, Wood, Fire and Earth on the grid leaving only the high paying symbol which are the mythical animals. Afterward, a subsequent drop process will follow.

Symbols that have been eliminated by the Fire Dragon doesn't produce any winning payout. The Fire Dragon goal is to eliminate low payout symbols, create gaps in the grid and produce a subsequent drop to give you a chance to get more winning clusters.

Wood Dragon Feature

When the Wood Dragon comes into play, it will fly towards a random symbol on the grid turning every single one of them into another symbol on the paytable chosen randomly.

Earth Dragon Feature

When the Earth Dragon comes into play, it will select two areas of 2x2 on the grid and turn all of them into the same symbol. The two areas are selected randomly, and they can touch each other but they cannot overlap. It is possible that the symbol that will be populated in the two areas is the regular wild symbol.

Golden Dragon Special Feature

When the Golden Dragon comes into play, you will be transported to the Golden World automatically. The Golden Dragon will create two different events that may produce big winnings payout.

Event 1 – Golden Dragon Roar

The Golden Dragon face will appear on the grid and occupy an area of 3x3 squares and then populate them with Golden Wilds. All winning combinations produced with one or more Golden Wild are paid with a x8 win multiplier. When every winning has been resolved and the symbols that are part of those winnings cluster have exploded, the round will carry on with a subsequent drop. After the new symbols have fallen to fill in the gap in the grid, the game will proceed right away with the second event of the Golden Dragon Special Feature even if there are winning clusters on the grid.

Event 2 – Lucky 8 Golden Wild Scatter

The Golden Dragon will appear again and fly across the main grid and substitute 8 symbols on the grid to Golden Wild. The game will then proceed with paying and treating the winning clusters. Once all winnings have been resolved, the game will continue with a subsequent drop of symbols.

If there are Golden Wild that did not explode, it will stay on the grid until the end of the game.

It is not possible that the game produces a regular wild during the Golden Dragon round because the background world has been changed to Golden world and there are no gold symbols. Once the Golden Dragon special feature ends, the background world will revert to the previous one before this special feature has been triggered.

Dragon Blessing

After the initial drop, if there is no winning cluster, one of the five dragons might appear on the game to give you a blessing and transform between 4 to 7 regular game symbols to become regular wild symbols giving you a chance to obtain a winning cluster.

Terms and Return to Player

In the event of a game in real play being interrupted, (i.e. started but not completed due to connectivity issues or accidentally closing the browser, etc.), depending on the previous state of the game, it will either resume from the point of the symbol falls or display the outcome of the game already in play. Any winnings will be correctly credited to the player account and will be exact according to the result prior to the game being interrupted.

In the event of a non-responsive game or problem during a bonus round, the game will repeat the incomplete game and display the result to the player when the game is next launched.

The odds of getting a particular outcome are always the same at the start of every game. The odds do not vary based on prior outcomes, bet size, balance size, time of day, day of the week, etc. For example, if the top award is won on a given play of the game, the chances of winning the top award on the next play are the same. Likewise, prior losses do not change future odds.

The theoretical average return to player (RTP) is 95.73%. This RTP represents the long- term expected payback of the game. Malfunction voids all pays and plays.

Menu

Home

The home button returns you to the casino lobby.

Pay table

Within the game menu, press the "i" icon to view pay table and game information.

Help

Within the game menu, the "?" icon opens the game's help file.

Sound / Music
